Program Description

Making the decision to pursue a career in combined training can be a difficult decision. It involves having the courage to pursue your dreams and passions, and the determination to follow a unique path. Once on that path, the transition from medical student to combined-trained resident can be challenging. As you progress through training you begin to explore what combined training means to you and how you want to practice. Finding someone who has chosen a similar path, to discuss and help you develop your vision of combined training can be difficult.

General Information

- The AMP Member-in-Training mentorship program is available to AMP members who are:
 - o Medical students interested in combined training
 - o Combined trained residents in their PGY1 – PGY4 year of a combined training program
 - o Combined trained residents in any year of their sequential training (e.g. Internal medicine followed by psychiatry, psychiatry followed by family medicine, etc.)
 - o Note: A special mentorship program is offered to PGY5 residents. See – AMP Transition to Practice mentorship program.
 - Mentors are members of the AMP. There are NO financial obligations for the mentor in this process.
